CASCADES CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RECAPS

MICHIGAN CTR 48, BRONSON 20

Michigan Center went to the air to notch its first win of the season, beating Bronson Friday 48-20.

Adrien Putnam was 20-24 passing for 380 yards and five touchdowns. Kyran Lane was on the receiving end of six passes for 148 yards and a score. Hunter Clemons had five receptions for 100 yards and three touchdowns.

Brody Shannon had two catches for 37 yards and a touchdown and also rushed four times for 80 yards and another score. Lane also had a rushing touchdown.

Michigan Center's defense was equally adept at stopping the pass, as Lukas Howard and Braylen Brown had interceptions.

GRASS LAKE 41, EAST JACKSON 0

The Warriors got 183 rushing yards and three touchdowns from Andrew Stockton and 158 passing yards and two touchdowns from Brayden Lape in a win over East Jackson.

Lape hit Robert Anderson for a 50-yard score to open the game. Lape also connected with Jacob Collins on a 49-yard touchdown. Stockton had a pair of 20-yard rushing touchdowns in the first half and an eight-yard score in the third quarter.

Jack Reid had nine tackles for Grass Lake. Willy Higgins had a pair of sacks.

Caleb Weaver had 53 of the Trojans' 75 rushing yards. Austin Tingley had 49 passing yards.

ADDISON 48, H-H 39

A second-half scoring surge helped Addison beat Hanover-Horton.

The Comets led 23-22 early in the third before touchdowns by Joe Clark, Keelan Mullin and Spencer Brown put the Panthers in front 40-23.

The Comets answered with a 60-yard Luke Soper-to-Graham Gumper touchdown pass to get within nine before Clark added another score.

Soper also had a 56-yard touchdown pass to Logan Blackledge and a four-yard strike to Gumper. Davan Ackley ran for a score and Gavan Teller scored on a blocked punt.

Mullin had three touchdowns for Addison and Jaxon Whittemore added a score.

Blackledge had three catches for 144 yards for the Comets. Soper was 8-of-16 for 227 yards.

NAPOLEON 30, MANCHESTER 25

MANCHESTER -- Through six lead changes and an hour-long delay for lightning, Napoleon came away from Manchester on Saturday

with a 30-25 win over the Flying Dutchmen and first place in the Cascades Conference.

The game, pushed back until Saturday due to the availability of officials, saw another delay due to lightning. With 1:33 left in the second quarter and Manchester leading 13-12, but with Napoleon driving, a flash of lightning halted things and what had been a steady rain began to pour.

What had been a 30-minute delay grew longer when another flash of lightning tore through the sky.

When lightning halted things Manchester had just taken the lead on a touchdown pass from Kannon Duffing to Jaxon McGuigan with 2:11 left in the half, but a decent kick return set Napoleon up for a chance to score before the half.

When play resumed, a 30-yard Bart Laretz run put the Pirates at the Manchester 1, and two plays later Grant Bradley cashed in with a quarterback keeper to put Napoleon ahead 18-13.

"I'm happy we got [the delay]," Laretz said. "I just sat there and listened to the coaches speak and just knew we were the better team over all."

"[Scoring right before halftime] was a big factor. We had short time, we didn't let them score afterwards, so that was a big momentum changer for us."

That lead only lasted until Manchester's first possession of the second half. The Flying Dutchmen used a 12-play, 56-yard scoring drive burning 5:08 off the clock to go back in front 19-18, converting three third downs in the process including an 11-yard gain by Duffing and the touchdown by Blake Sloan from five yards out.

That lead lasted just over a minute. Laretz raced up the middle on the first play of the ensuing drive to get the Pirates into Manchester territory, and two plays later Bradley scrambled to his right, lowered the shoulder to get past a defender, and raced 38 yards to the end zone.

"I know what I can do," Bradley said. "Through my years it's always felt good to lower my shoulder. It may not feel good after the game, but it feels good during the game. I saw one dude and thought 'I can get through this' and went right through him."

After forcing Manchester to punt, Napoleon solidified the lead with a 12-play, 65-yard drive burning 7:06 off the clock. That drive as well saw Laretz get things off to a strong start, racing up the middle on the first play of the drive for 24 yards to get the ball into Manchester territory.

"We just run what we run," Napoleon coach Derek Shell said. "We put the ball in our play-makers' hands and we ran behind the guys that do all the work for us. Those guys wanted to win and those are the seniors on our offensive line running Bart Laretz, who's put in a ton of time putting in a transformation."

Bradley also converted a fourth down with a keeper later in the drive, and scored on another keeper from seven yards out, making it 30-19.

Manchester got within a score with a quick-strike three-play drive set up by Gunner Carson's 44-yard kick return. Duffing hit McGuigan for a 36-yard gain on the second play of the drive to get the Flying Dutchmen to the Napoleon 3, then Duffing took it himself on the next play for the score.

But with 3:24 left on the clock, Manchester never got the ball back. Napoleon runs on the first two plays of the drive were stopped for losses, but on third-and-12 Bradley rolled to his right and hit Holden VanPoppel for a 27-yard gain and a first down. Napoleon was able to run out the clock from there.

Laretz had 21 carries for 218 yards and a touchdown. Bradley had 13 carries for 101 yards and four touchdowns.

"We got away from what we do, running power and iso and smash-mouth football, but we got back to it and good things happened for us," Shell said.

Napoleon improves to 3-0 overall, 2-0 in league play. The only other Cascades Conference team unbeaten in league play so far is Grass Lake, who has only played one league game. The Pirates host Springport next week.

Manchester falls to 2-1 overall, 1-1 in conference and will visit East Jackson next week.
